More Details:

1. Music Sales - A half dozen teachers participated.
2. Amplifier give-away - donation from 1 teacher.
3. Giving Month - 1 teacher. Emails sent to membership (45).
4. Giving Month - 1 business - LR Violin Shop only response. Letters sent to 15 music businesses.
5. Playathon - teachers will generally add to the donations of their students.

As near as I can tell, these money-making projects involved a total of seven of our teachers. Think what could happen if ten or a dozen got involved! However, in this era of a few lost jobs and students, teaching income is probably less.

Possible ideas for the future of Giving Month:

- 1 - Do it after the pandemic is over, when income is closer to 'normal.'
- 2 - Do it some other month besides November.
- 3 - Send out cards/letters by USPS to teachers.

Another idea: Money for yearbook ads could go into the SF. We are covering the cost well, with our nice balance in the general checking account fund.
